Morning Report – Saturday – November 28, 2009

Weather Forecast:

Today Mostly cloudy with a 50% chance of rain and snow showers. Light wind 10 to 15 mph in the afternoon. Snow level 5000 feet. High in the mid 60s.

Tonight Mostly cloudy with a 20% chance of rain showers. Northwest wind around 10 mph. Low in the lower 40s.

Tomorrow Mostly sunny. High in the lower 70s. Low around 40.

Extended Mostly sunny and clear. Highs in the low 70s. Lows in the upper 30s to low 40s.

Current Road Conditions:

Big Pine Road Open; high clearance recommended due to washouts.

Eureka Dunes Road..... Open; high clearance recommended due to washouts.

Keane Wonder Rd CLOSED; road and mining area closed to all entry due to mine-safety hazards.

Saline Valley-N Pass Open; high clearance 4x4 recommended.

Saline Valley-S Pass..... Open; high-clearance recommended.

Scotty's Castle Road..... Open; expect short delays due to road construction Monday thru Thursday.

Titus Canyon Road Open; high clearance recommended.

Roads outside Death Valley:

CA Hwy 120 (Tioga Pass), CA Hwy 4, CA Hwy 108 & CA Hwy 120....Closed due to snow

CA Hwy 395.....Chains or snow tires from 17 miles North of Bishop to the Nevada State Line. High wind advisory.
